**TO THE UNIVERSITY OF EUROREGIONAL ECONOMY
IN JÓZEFÓW-WARSAW**

University of Euroregional Economy (WSGE) was created by a decision of the Minister of National Education and Sport DSW-3-4001-689/TT/02 on 18 November 2002 and registered as private university under the identification number 115 (currently no. 257). For Polish students, university offers programmes in the following areas: management, administration, internal security, diplomatic law. For international students University offers Business Administration and Hotel and Tourism Management (Bachelor's degree) and Business Administration, Hospitality and Tourism Management, Business Information Systems, Health Care Management and Engineering Management (Master's degree).

Accordingly to Bologna Process, Bachelor's degree last for 3 years and Master's degree lasts for 2 years. After graduation students have chance to stay in Poland on the basis of 1 year job-seeking visa. Moreover, we do implement European Union programmes in amount of 2 mln euro in total. The most important proof for successful implementation of these programmes is the creation of a platform, used for distance learning.

Moreover, facilities like paid internship in a good 5 star hotel, good practical education, Erasmus program makes our University different from other Universities and ranked one of the top University in Poland.

Poland is a country in the Central Europe. This is the place where in 1989 all democratic changes in Europe and in the world have started. Nowadays Poland is one of the leaders in GDP in EU. It is located in between the Baltic Sea in the north and Carpathian Mountains in the south.

POLISH LARGEST AND MOST DYNAMIC CITY

Warsaw (Polish: Warszawa) is a capital and the largest city in Poland. It is located on the Vistula River, roughly 260 kilometres (160 miles) from the Baltic Sea and 300 kilometres (190 miles) from the Carpathian Mountains. Its population is estimated closely to 3 mln residents, making Warsaw the 9th most populous city in the European Union. Warsaw is an Alpha-global city, a major international tourist destination and an important economic hub in Central Europe. It is also known as the "phoenix city" because it has survived many wars throughout its history. Most notably, the city has been painstakingly rebuilt after the extensive damage it suffered from the World War II, during which 85% of its buildings were destroyed.

Our academic year includes 2 semesters which begin on 1st October and End of February, winter holidays – 2 weeks, summer holidays – 3 months (July-August-September). Classes are being held in the amount of approx. 20-25 lessons (4 times a week, 5 lessons a day). The courses finish with a written or oral examination. Exams (3 attempts) are free of charges. During the studies students can join language courses and organized summer school.
